Reflection - "I never get tired of telling that story" - Today is a Day of Testimony

Today is a special day, a day that will be full of testimony that I hope and pray you will hear, receive and through which you may be blessed. Scripture is rammed full of statements about the importance of testimony. Indeed 1 John 1 begins: we declare to you what was from the beginning, what we have heard, what we have seen with our eyes, what we have looked at and touched with our hands concerning the word of life... They are of course, proclaiming from the very beginning of their dialogue that this is the story of Jesus Christ. I hope that today will remind us that when we may feel that we don't have the words or understanding to explain the nature of salvation, all we have to do instead is to tell our own story of the love of Jesus Christ and what impact that God has had on our lives.

Testimony – JOSEPHINE AM SOON

A life of being Called and Sent by a God who is amazing.God has called me to be part of His story

Introduction:

A story of God calling me into the ministry - how God has intervened into my situation/come into my life and rescued me when I needed Him. A story of God calling and sending me to serve, even me!!

I hope to share with you a few highlights from the last 10 years ...

1st Highlight: My 'Burning Bush' which leads to my 'Holy Ground'

God called me from a child of God/ a follower to be a servant of God / a messenger who bring His voice to the world.

Reading: Exodus 3:1-6

Moses was keeping the flock of his father-in-law Jethro, the priest of Midian; he led his flock beyond the wilderness, and came to Horeb, the mountain of God. There the angel of the Lord appeared to him in a flame of fire out of a bush; he looked, and the bush was blazing, yet it was not consumed. Then Moses said, "I must turn aside and look at this great sight, and see why the bush is not burned up." When the Lord saw that he had turned aside to see, God called to him out of the bush, "Moses, Moses!" And he said, "Here I am." Then he said, "Come no closer! Remove the sandals from your feet, for the place on which you are standing is holy ground." He said further, "I am the God of your father, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob." And Moses hid his face, for he was afraid to look at God.

My Burning Bush & my 'Holy Ground' - Verse 3: "I must turn aside and look'

I moved to North Derbyshire – Cliff College. In fact – both Nathaniel and me were sent by God to live in the seminary that year. In my mind – this was our one year mission before I planned to move back to Malaysia.

'Remove the sandals from my feet...' and go/stand before God...

- The comfort / 'protection/ security' and be vulnerable/ open/ bare
- Leave all dust/ burden/chains and be clean again

The journey starts....'The Summons' means a lot for us.

The name of this hymn is called 'The Summons' - it means 'the calling and sending to ... ' in order to do God's will.

StF 673 – Will you come and follow me (The Summons)

- Will you come and follow Me if I but call your name?
 Will you go where you don't know and never be the same?
 Will you let My love be shown?
 Will you let My name be known,
 Will you let My life be grown in you and you in Me?
- 4) Will you love the 'you' you hide if I but call your name?
 Will you quell the fear inside and never be the same?
 Will you use the faith you've found To reshape the world around, Through My sight and touch and sound in you and you in Me?





- Will you leave yourself behind if I but call your name?
 Will you care for cruel and kind and never be the same?
 Will you risk the hostile stare
 Should your life attract or scare?
 Will you let Me answer prayer in you and you in Me?
- Will you let the blinded see if I but call your name?
 Will you set the prisoners free and never be the same?
 Will you kiss the leper clean And do such as this unseen, And admit to what I mean in you and you in Me?
- 5) Lord, Your summons echoes true when You but call my name,
 Let me turn and follow You and never be the same.
 In Your company I'll go
 Where Your love and footsteps show
 Thus I'll move and live and grow in You and You in me.

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Reading: Exodus 3:7-12

Then the Lord said, "I have observed the misery of my people who are in Egypt; I have heard their cry on account of their taskmasters. Indeed, I know their sufferings, and I have come down to deliver them from the Egyptians, and to bring them up out of that land to a good and broad land, a land flowing with milk and honey, to the country of the Canaanites, the Hittites, the Amorites, the Perizzites, the Hivites, and the Jebusites. The cry of the Israelites has now come to me; I have also seen how the Egyptians oppress them. So come, I will send you to Pharaoh to bring my people, the Israelites, out of Egypt." But Moses said to God, "Who am I that I should go to Pharaoh, and bring the Israelites out of Egypt?" He said, "I will be with you; and this shall be the sign for you that it is I who sent you: when you have brought the people out of Egypt, you shall worship God on this mountain."

2nd Highlight: It does not matter about 'why me?' (v 11)

Ten years learning to fix my eyes on Jesus/ the way being a Christian <u>Good news:</u>

- I do not need to know God's whole plan
- I DO NOT NEED TO KNOW HOW TO 'DO' IT
- The fact is I was worried and scared like Peter walking on the water

The First Year – God revealed His call for me to preach and lead and teach

First sermon I preached was in the Chapel in college. Then in circuits – the Connexion – international churches (Outside of the local community)

<u>The Second Year</u> – God called me to do something different – He sent the right people to me

- Inspire Movement
- Discipleship (more toward inner community ministry)
- Christian leadership, mentoring, Wesleyan Spirituality

All for Christ (I am yours, you are mine),

Christ for All (We are to be more like Christ – to feed the poor and hungry until they are satisfied)

Reading: John 4:31-42

Meanwhile the disciples were urging him, "Rabbi, eat something." **But he said to them, "I have food to eat that you do not know about.**" So the disciples said to one another, "Surely no one has brought him something to eat?" Jesus said to them, **"My food is to do the will of him who sent me and to complete his work.** Do you not say, 'Four months more, then comes the harvest'? But I tell you, look around you, and see how the fields are ripe for harvesting. The reaper is already receiving wages and is gathering fruit for eternal life, so that sower and reaper may rejoice together. For here the saying holds true, 'One sows and another reaps.' I sent you to reap that for which you did not labour. Others have laboured, and you have entered into their labour."

3rd Highlight: 'food' that satisfied my soul

The Fruits (harvest): Not of the worldly recognition / titles ie certificates/ degrees But – looking for the Harvest in Jesus's vine yard/ God's Kingdom:

God has used me to bring people to faith
 God has used me to help many believers who are hungry to grow mature in their faith & to make disciples of Jesus – teaching & nurturing them through small band meetings
 God has used me to bring up a Christian young man who loves Jesus – my son.
 God has answered many of my prayers for others and answered the prayers of many through me
 A blessing of a new relationship







Conclusion:

All glory to God the Father, Son and the Holy Spirit. From a child of God/ a follower of our Lord Jesus Christ to be a servant of God/ a messenger of God's voice... to be a tool to attract people around Jesus and a channel/ a cup to enable people to drink from the Living water.

Good news:

- I do not need to know God's whole plan
- I DO NOT NEED TO KNOW HOW TO 'DO' IT
- I do not need to give anything but only your NEW HEART

Faith is:

Believe the rewards for us may be here on earth – but will be greater in Heaven without end.

So if God has called me, even me, He calls you too. I have decided to follow Jesus, to let Him teach me/ equip me. I have let Him be my Lord and Master – to led me step by step. Will you be another one? From a child of God to be a servant of God and to be the cup/plate that holds the Living Water and the Bread of Life to the world?

You have seen what I did to the Egyptians, and how I bore you on eagles' wings and brought you to myself. Now therefore, **if you obey my voice and keep my covenant, you shall be** my treasured possession out of all the peoples.
